## **Brotherhood Level**

- 1. Candidate must have completed the Ordeal Master Training (CA/AA)
- 2. Candidate must complete the post training mini quiz to show their knowledge of the information (CC/AC)
- 3. Candidate must have completed the New Member Page for the Amangamek-Wipit Lodge (CC/AC)
- 4. Candidate must complete the National Jumpstart Online page (CC/AC)

## **Cheerful Level**

- 1. Candidate must staff at least one Ordeal at the chapter or area level (CA/AA)
- 2. Candidate must serve as one of the following (CC/AC)
  - a. Assistant Ordeal Master
  - b. Head Ceremonialist
  - c. Service Head
  - d. Cook Crew Head
- 3. Candidate must complete a reflection, post Ordeal, about the planning process and execution of the oredal and changes they would make (CA/AA)

## Service Level

- 1. Candidate must be chosen by their chapter or area to run an ordeal (CC/AC)
- 2. Candidate must complete a complete list for their ordeal team including (CC/AC)
  - a. Assistant Ordeal Master (1)
  - b. Head Elangomat (1)
  - c. Elangomats (Number as needed)
  - d. Head Ceremonialist
  - e. Ceremonies Team
  - f. Service Head
  - g. Service Team
  - h. Cook Crew Head
  - i. Cooke Crew Team
- 3. Candidate must complete a back-dating list prior to the date of the Ordeal (CA)
- 4. Candidate must have a complete schedule completed prior to the date of the Ordeal (CA)
- 5. Candidate must have taken Trainers EDGE (CA/AA)
- 6. Candidate must have completed Train the Trainer (CA/AA)
- 7. Candidate must register under the Training Committee as a trainer for the Ordeal Master Training (CC/AC)
- 8. Candidate must have trained at two chapter or lodge trainings\* (CC/AC)
