Requirement/Activity	Explanation
Required:	
Amangamek-Wipit Flap on Uniform	Wear your new Lodge patch on the flap of the right hand uniform shirt pocket.
Attend at Least 2 Chapter Meetings	Chapters meet once a month with the exception of July. Attend 2 of those meetings.
Complete Your Brotherhood Conversion	Six months after your Ordeal, you are eligible. See your Chapter Chief or Adviser for more info.
Membership Dues Current	Spring Ordeals pay Nov 1 of current year, Fall Ordeals pay Nov 1 of following year.
Participate Actively in Your Unit	An Arrowman's first duty is to their unit. Be active for at least 6 months.
Attend One Camping Event	
Lodge Spring Fellowship	Come camping with Scouts and Leaders from our Lodge in April. Dining hall food and lots of fun!
Lodge Fall Fellowship	Another camping opportunity with the Lodge in September.
Section E10 Conclave	Camping with Arrowmen from our Section: Wipit, Nentego and Nentiko Lodges in May.

Chapter Service Project	Participate with your Chapter in a service project. See your Chapter Chief or Adviser for details.

Staff an Ordeal	Become a general staff member of the next Ordeal after your own.
Attend an OA Training Event	Want to learn more about leadership in the OA? Join us for a training day!
Chapter or Lodge Officer/Committee Member	Looking for a new challenge? The Chapters and Lodge need lots of help, jobs big and small.
Attend the Lodge Banquet	The Chapters come together for the annual awards banquet in January.
